


How to save a search

The TLG allows you to save up to 10 searches to review at a later time. The “save” option is available in the Canon and Text Search pages.

In the Canon page, your search selections are displayed in the right-hand sidebar. By clicking on the Save icon  your selections will be saved in your account.

Date: Prints the date each search was saved.

Annotation: An additional box is provided for your own annotation. Click on "Apply Changes" to save the annotation.

Edit: Gives you the option to delete items from a saved search or modify an existing search and save the results as a new search.

Delete: Click on the box to permanently delete a search.
